
























- Snake: points to the 4th cell of the 4th row.

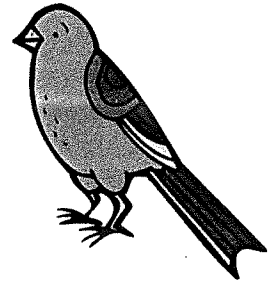

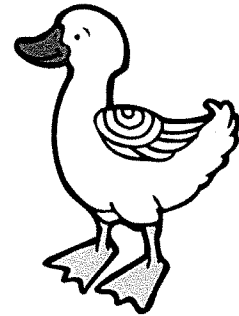

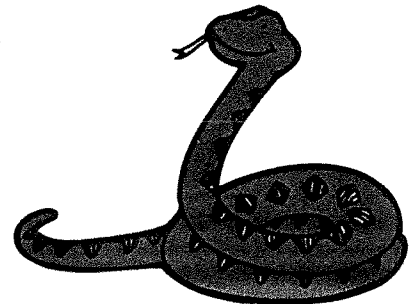
